French ban of Monsanto GM maize rejected by EU

France's attempt to ban the planting of a Monsanto strain of genetically modified maize was rejected by the EU's <u>food</u> safety body on Monday. In response to scientific evidence submitted by France backing its bid to ban the <u>GM</u> maize, the <u>European Food Safety Authority ruled that</u> "there is no specific scientific evidence, in terms of risk to human and animal health or the environment" to support a ban.
