Police keep anti-GM protestors in UK from destroying wheat crop

<u>Police</u> kept hundreds of protesters at bay as they attempted to destroy a field where genetically modified wheat is being tested in Hertfordshire. Mounted officers helped bring activists to a halt in front of the entrance to land owned by the <u>Rothamsted research institute</u>, which is testing <u>GM</u> wheat which has been enhanced to fight aphid infestation.
