20 years of GMO policy keeps Americans in the dark, says GMO opposer

Popular resistance is boiling over on the GMO labeling issue, as the *New York Times* reported last week in <u>a front-page story</u>. More than a million people have asked the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for mandatory labeling of genetically engineered food on a <u>legal petition</u> in March and on May 2, nearly a million voter signatures were submitted in California to place a GMO labeling initiative on ballot in November. Clearly, Americans believe strongly in their right to know what's in their food.
