How California's GM food referendum may change what America eats

Last month, nearly 1m signatures were delivered to county registrars throughout <u>California</u> calling for a referendum on the labeling of genetically engineered foods. If the measure, <u>"The Right to Know Genetically Engineered Food Act"</u>, which will be on the ballot in November, passes, California will become the first state in the nation to require that GM foods be labeled as such on the package.

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
