Biofuels 'dead' without U.S. aid

Famed genomics researcher J. Craig Venter, who is working to develop biofuels from photosynthetic algae, acknowledged this week that alternate fuels are "dead" unless the federal government mandates their use with a carbon policy.

Venter's <u>strongly worded statement</u> came Tuesday night at the annual Stem Cell Meeting on the Mesa, after he was asked when synthetic biology might have a meaningful impact on the country's energy production.
