## Neanderthal clones unlikely, experts say

A Harvard geneticist has raised eyebrows by <u>declaring</u> that scientists could make a <u>Neanderthal</u> clone baby if they had an "extremely adventurous female human" as a surrogate.

When geneticist George Church talked about cloning Neanderthals in his book and subsequent <u>interview</u> with Der Spiegel news weekly, it sounded like something out of Michael Crichton's "Jurassic Park" coming to life. But experts say that safety and ethical hang-ups mean the first Neanderthal birth in 30,000 years is probably fiction, too.
