Three years after an international team of experts led by researchers at the [Max Planck Institute for Evolutionary Anthropology](#) in Leipzig, Germany published a [“draft” of the genome of *Homo neanderthalensis*](#) (commonly known as the “Neanderthal”), the team has [come back](#) with a higher-quality “finished” map of the genome. The DNA comes from sequencing of Neanderthal toe-bone found in Siberia
