Southern Europeans more African than thought

Southern Europeans get a significant portion of their genetic ancestry from North Africa, new research suggests.

The findings, published today June 3, 2013 in the journal *Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences*, suggest the impact of these connections went beyond culture and architecture, and may explain why Southern Europeans have more genetic diversity than their northern counterparts.
