## Catholic leaders: Transgenic plants must be used to feed poor

As did Cardinal Turkson in Des Moines, the Pontifical Academy of Sciences *statement s*peaks to many of the concerns raised by those who object to genetic modifications within the food supply—concerns like greed, organizational corruption, scientific uncertainty, and so many other characteristics of our fallen human race.
