

Threats from antis make it difficult to know what the silent majority believes in Hawaii about GMOs

The fact that many opponents of GMOs are so vociferous and uncivil in expressing their opposition, and that some politicians, like the Kauai County Mayor, have received death threats raises uncomfortable questions. Are most GMO opponents in Hawaii this intemperate or are these posts and protests representative of only an activist minority? The fear of being personally threatened makes it impossible to know what the silent majority in Kaua'i and the Big Island really believe.
