

## Retraction! Prestigious journal pulls botched Seralini GMO rat study

*Food and Chemical Toxicology*, which last year published the now notorious GMO rat study by French scientist Gilles-Éric Seralini that suggested that a genetically modified corn variety led to a high incidence of cancers, will be retracted and evidence of it expunged from the journal's database.

As [reported in the French media](#), the editor of the journal, A. Wallace Hayes, has sent Seralini a letter saying that the paper will be retracted if Seralini does not agree to withdraw it.
