

What's ahead for BRCA genetic testing and counseling?

The US Supreme Court's landmark decision last June, mandating that an individual's genes cannot be patented, transformed the genetic testing landscape and opened the marketplace to a host of new and complicated testing options.

That decision—alongside actress Angelina Jolie's highly publicized choice to undergo a prophylactic double mastectomy due to her family history and her own BRCA mutation status—have shined a spotlight on hereditary cancer risk, presenting both opportunities and challenges for today's oncology practitioner.
