
Talking Biotech: NAS committee member Neal Stewart on GM crops: It's all safe, environmentally friendly

Talking Biotech returns with an interview with University of Tennessee's Dr. Neal Stewart, who is also a member of the National Academy of Science's committee responsible for the recent report that concluded <u>GMOs to be safe</u>. The <u>Genetically Engineered Crops report</u> was commissioned by the National Academies of Science, and a committee was convened to review the current literature. The committee also considered testimony of experts, including self-described experts. A wide range of opinions were considered.
