TALEs (Transcription Activator-Like Effectors) are natural proteins made and used by harmful plant bacteria to control plant genes during infection

modify TALEs into TALENs



design TALENs to target selected, specific DNA sequences





make a cut in the targeted DNA sequence




initiate the cell's own repair mechanisms to remove or introduce new DNA at the target site
